CANCER AND INTERVENTIONAL ONCOLOGY

Worldwide

- In 2012, the worldwide number of new cases of cancer rose to an estimated 14 million¹.
- This figure is expected to rise to an annual figure of 22 million over the next two decades².
- Over the same period, cancer deaths are predicted to rise from an estimated 8.2 million annually to 13 million per year³.
- 50% of people in England and Wales diagnosed with cancer today will survive the disease for at least 10 years according to recent landmark figures published by Cancer Research UK⁴. In the early 1970s, only a quarter of people diagnosed with cancer in this region survived 10 years.
- Primary liver cancer is the second leading cause of cancer deaths⁵.

Treatment

Cancer care has several areas of treatment - surgery, medical oncology (i.e. chemotherapy immunotherapy, hormonal therapy and angiogenesis inhibitors), radiation therapy and interventional oncology⁶.

Interventional oncology

- Interventional oncology is a minimally invasive treatment that directly targets cancer tumors using advanced image-guided technology. It's considered to be one of the newest and more aggressive options in cancer treatment today⁷.
- Philips' new EmboGuide solution supports the image-guided procedures called embolization procedures typically used to treat primary liver cancer. Embolization is a procedure that injects solid or semi-solid substances (chemo) to try to block or reduce the blood flow to cancer cells⁸. Embolization of liver tumors is intended to improve a patient's quality of life and to prolong a patient's life.
- The market for interventional oncology as a whole is growing annually by 15% (CAGR).
