

## The Lancashire Cardiac Centre upgrades its Cardiac Cath Lab

The Lancashire Cardiac Centre, part of Blackpool Victoria Hospital, recently upgraded to Philips Azurion 7 Biplane Cath Lab. The new equipment, which comes with integrated EP facilities, replaced an existing Philips cardiac lab. With two 12" flat detectors, and a host of innovative software, the Azurion 7 provides high-resolution imaging and positioning flexibility to reveal critical anatomical information during electrophysiology procedures and device implants procedures. We are finding the whole system very user-friendly, and particularly useful is the central touch screen facility which allows the user to change the layout of the screens at the touch of a finger. Another important feature for us is the optimised image quality in combination with the dose reduction that we are achieving with the new equipment."

With Philips central touch screen module the user can control all compatible applications via the central touch screen module. Not only does this improve workflow within the exam room, but also helps reduce the need for the team to leave the sterile area and walk to the control room during procedures. This can save time and avoid delays. In addition, Azurion 7 also uses a range of ProcedureCards to help optimise and standardise system set-up for all cases, from routine to advanced cases, helping to safeguard consistency and minimise preparation errors.

Sadaqat Ali, commenting on the installation of the new equipment, including hardware, which took place during the COVID pandemic said: "Due to travel restrictions, Philips' local engineers took care of the whole project, which went very smoothly.
