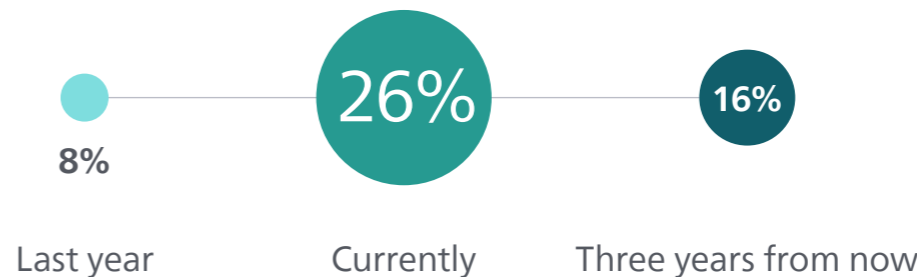

Emerging from the pandemic, healthcare leaders across Saudi Arabia identify three priorities for 2022 and beyond.

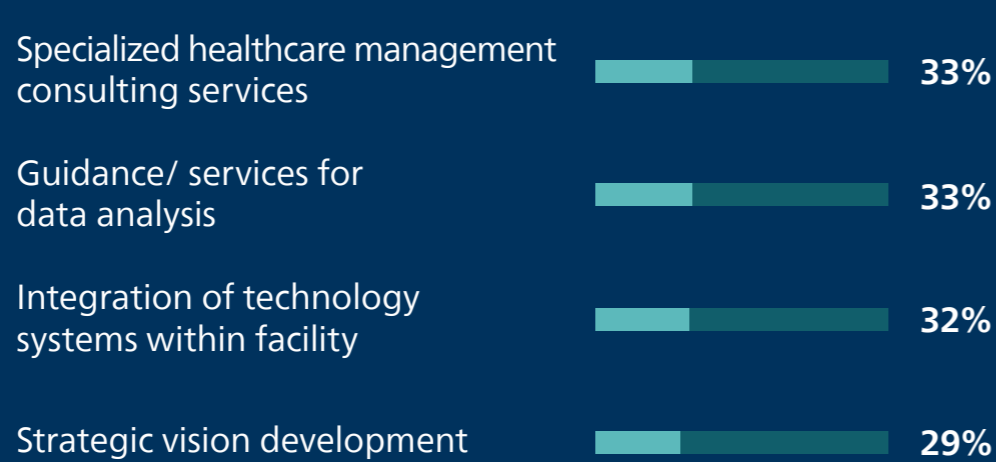
Remaining at the forefront of healthcare delivery and expanding patient care are top of the agenda for Saudi Arabian healthcare leaders

The support healthcare leaders seek from health technology companies



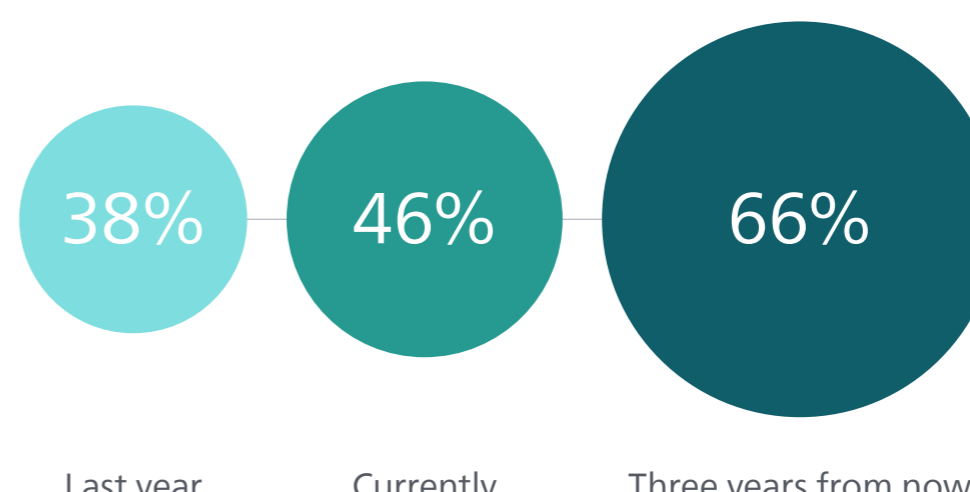
Saudi Arabian healthcare leaders realize that partnerships are key to success

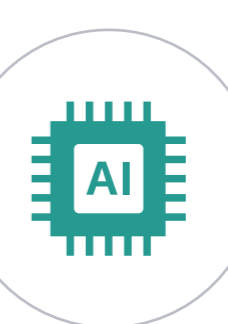
